



## Annual Wastewater Collection System Report January 1, 2018 - December 31, 2018

### Introduction:

In an effort to keep its citizens informed and maintain compliance with State of North Carolina requirements, the Town of Elon is pleased to provide this annual overview of the operation, maintenance, and performance of its wastewater collection system.

### About our Collection System

The sewer collection system is owned, operated and maintained by the Town. It consists of approximately 47 miles of gravity sewer lines, 0.3 miles of pressure lines, and one sewer pump station. Each day we transport an average of 552,000 gallons of wastewater to the South Burlington Wastewater Treatment Plant and 212,000 gallons of wastewater to the East Burlington Wastewater Treatment Plants for final treatment. Town staff routinely inspects our system and use high pressure washing and closed circuit television monitoring to maintain the main lines.

### System Performance

The Town works hard to ensure the collection system is operated and maintained at a high level. The Town did not have any sanitary sewer overflows during the calendar.
