

## Elon shooting suspect turns himself in

An Elon man wanted in connection with the killing Feb. 5 of a 22-year-old and the shooting of his ex-girlfriend turned himself in Thursday, Feb. 13.

Barry “BJ” Campbell surrendered himself at the Elon Police Department just after 8:15 p.m. He was charged with murder, and assault with a deadly weapon with intent to kill.

Town of Elon officers were dispatched to Campbell’s Pindale Drive home about 9 a.m. Feb. 5. There they found Nickolas Marquis Johnson, 22, and Maureen Chafatelli, also 22, suffering from gunshot wounds.

The shooting has since been deemed a domestic incident as Campbell and Chafatelli were previously dating. According to police, the two had broken up the night before.

Campbell allegedly left his home for a short time Wednesday morning before he came back and found Chafatelli and Johnson there, and shot them. Johnson died on the way to the hospital, while Chafatelli was hospitalized.

Campbell is being held in the county jail without bail.
